

Developing the role of the Middle Leader

OBJECTIVES COURSE

The four sessions will provide middle or subject leaders, particularly those new to their role, the opportunity to identify characteristics of great leadership. The leaders will develop practical approaches to their role so that they have the confidence to support and lead others. The leaders will also complete two 'gap tasks' during the course to enable them to reflect on their role and to develop stronger leadership qualities.

CONTENTS COURSE

- Identify the role and responsibilities of Middle/Subject Leaders.
- Identify the difference between leadership and management so that Middle Leaders are clear about their role.
- Develop our understanding of improving the quality of teaching, learning and assessment within our phase/role through monitoring and evaluation activities.
- Reflect on our leadership activities and practice - identify our impact through the evidence we collect.
- Develop our coaching skills so that we can support and grow others in our team.
- Develop the skills, knowledge, and confidence to lead a high-performing team in a school.
- Reflect on and develop our own practice so that we can support others through two Gap Task activities.
